Public Feedback Welcome in Zoning Petition for Lawrence Village at the Fort

Indianapolis, Indiana – The Fort Harrison Reuse Authority (FHRA) will host a public forum to discuss zoning for the widely anticipated Lawrence Village at the Fort. The meeting will answer questions from the public about the upcoming live, work, play master-planned community.

Public's participation is encouraged on Monday, May 14, 2007, at 6:00 p.m. at the Robert Sterrett Center located on 8950 Otis Avenue, Lawrence, to discuss this zoning initiative. Fort Harrison Reuse Authority Executive Director Ehren Bingaman states, "This zoning effort takes the public feedback from our master planning process and establishes development standards that allow Lawrence Village at the Fort's vision to take shape and become a reality."

The proposed zoning change applies only to the Lawrence Village study area; property bounded by 56th Street, 59th Street, Post and Lee Roads. The Lawrence Village at the Fort development will uphold the character and architecture of the historic Fort; therefore, maintaining the vision of the existing Fort Harrison master-plan.

City of Lawrence Redevelopment Director Tom Crouch states, "I can't express how important public input has been and will continue to be on this new development. They are in charge; public involvement is critical in the redevelopment and improvement of our city."
