Indianapolis, Indiana – The Fort Harrison Reuse Authority (FHRA) is now accepting developer proposals for two parcels of land within the confines of the anticipated Lawrence Village at the Fort live, work, play village-style community. Upon the unanimous approval of the Lawrence City Council last week, FHRA is ready to proceed with the development and construction of the community by announcing the availability of proposals.

Available Property Development Details

Property parcel A is located in the northwest corner of the village's parameter and contains 10.58 acres of land to be developed as an urban residential neighborhood. Property parcel B is located between 56th Street and Wheeler Road and contains 5.70 acres of land for an urban mixed-use development.

Proposals are available beginning Thursday, June 7, 2007, with completed documents due Friday, July 20, 2007.
