Update from the Secretary Treasurer:

• Mr. Brown stated the monthly profit and loss was available for the public.

Update from Executive Director:

• Ms. Dunston stated the FHRA have sold two additional lots at the Residences at Lawrence Village with only one remaining and ground was broken on sixty additional units. The FHRA is still working on a development agreement for Parcel J for a Hilton Tru Hotel, a mixed-use office building a public parking garage and an Indianapolis Public Library branch. Details are being worked thru on Civic Plaza for a permanent stage and ADA accessibility. The FHRA still has 8 acres of Parcel J north for multi family use and are talking to multi family developers for that property. The FHRA is fixing a large pothole on Parcel B. The FHRA is still working with Context Landscape Architecture to take over the old PX building on Lawton Loop. The Village of Merici is still in negotiations on the Maude Building and that would leave no vacant structures on the Loop.

Ms. Dunston attended a meeting with IndyGo regarding the Purple Line. The Purple Line will connect to the Red Line from 56th and Post and come up to Otis and turn on Wheeler and then turn around at Ivy Tech and reverse out the same path. IndyGo has no consideration of a new route but may be able to consider additional stops later. IndyGo will repave everything they touch.

Ms. Reddick introduced meeting minutes from July 16, 2018. The motion for approval was made by Mr. Miller and seconded by Mr. Congdon. The minutes of the meeting were unanimously voted in favor. Ms. Reddick abstained as she was absent from the July meeting.
